from 3rd to 4th June 2022

in Roodepoort Gauteng , SOUTH AFRICA

Please note: all information is posted only for information purposes. All entrants must be Affiliated members in good standing with any approved IPF Federation.

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Host City: Roodepoort Gauteng, SOUTH AFRICA

Date: 3rd to 4th June 2022

Venue: Ruimsig Athletics Staduim, Handicap Road, Ruimsig Roodepoort

Hotel: Hotels must be booked individually. The organiser will not provide any hotel.

Entry Opening Date: 1 April 2022 at 12H00 Johannesburg time (GMT+2)
Entries will open at this time and date. Entries are limited to 10 male and 10 females in the Bench Press and Equipped Powerlifting and 20 male and 20 females in the Classic Powerlifting. Entries will be on a first come first serve basis, based on the date and time of the Prelim Entries received. In terms of IPF rules, this date is deemed to be the Preliminary Entry Date.

Last Date for Payment: 48 Hrs after Receipt of Confirmation of Entry
Payments must be made within 48hrs of receipt confirming your Entry, failing which your Entry will be forfeited. Payment details are all listed within the Invitation. Payment amounts will be in South African Rands. Doping Fee, plus one Entry Fee per Competition. Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis, based on the date and time of your Entry Submission. You will only be notified confirming your successful Entry and requesting payment if you are within the cut-off limits.

Final Date: 13 May 2022
Final Date for withdrawals, where a 10% cancellation fee will apply.

Airport – Hotel transport must be organized by each attendant individually

Participation Fee:

R1070 for each lifter per competition
Payments must be made within 48hrs of receipt confirming your Entry, failing which your Entry will be forfeited. Payment details are all listed within the Invitation. One Doping Fee, and one Entry per Competition. Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis, based on the date and time of your Entry Submission. You will only be notified confirming your successful Entry and requesting payment if you are within the cut-off limits.

Anti-Doping Fee:

R1070 irrespective of the number of Competitions entered

Qualifying Criteria:

In order to compete, you must have competed at atleast one competition within the last 12 months.

T-Shirts:

T-Shirts will be provided and included withing Participation fee

Health and Travel Insurance: All delegate members must have a valid health insurance (it is also obligatory to have it at customs). The organiser and the IPF will not incur any expenses for a doctor or a stay in hospital. We recommend the travel insurance for covering loss of luggage, theft, delayed planes etc.

COVID19 Regulations:

The Championship will be organised under strict COVID19 rules and regulations. IPF COVID Precautions are published on the webpage under the following link:

Additionally, the IPF will follow to 100% the COVID Rules and Regulations of the Government from the host country (South Africa). ALL participants must follow the rules of the IPF COVID Precautions and the Rules and Regulations of the South Africa Government. Failure to do so, will cause a disqualification and exclusion from the championship.

All scorings are based on IPF GL Points (no weight categories!)

All participants will receive a medal. The top 3 in each Session will Receive an award and the prize money according the list below.
