#### Who can enter?

- Lifters need to have qualified at a Provincial Championships, in the weight and age category they wish to compete in.
- All lifters must be affiliated for the current year.
- Only entries received by the Preliminary Entry date will be accepted.
- The only changes allowed in Final Entries are weight division changes, or withdrawals. No age division changes allowed with Final Entries – lifters must specify all age divisions they intend to compete in, with their Prelim Entry.

#### How to enter?

- For this event there is an *online entry form only* – please fill in the entry form on the SAPF website.
- Entry fees must be paid using the Payfast facility on the SAPF website.
- Payment must be made by Final Entry date to secure your entry.

Records: SA National Classic Powerlifting and Bench Press records can be set at this event, as well as Provincial records.

Youth	from the year the lifter turns 10 until the day before the lifter turns 14
Open	from the day the lifter reaches 14 years and upwards
SubJunior	from the day the lifter reaches 14 years and throughout the full calendar year in which he/she reaches 18 years
Junior	from 1 January in the calendar year the lifter reaches 19 years and throughout the full calendar year in which he/she reaches 23
Master 1	from 1 January in the calendar year the lifter reaches 40 years and throughout the full calendar year in which he/she reaches 49
Master 2	from 1 January in the calendar year the lifter reaches 50 years and throughout the full calendar year in which he/she reaches 59
Master 3	from 1 January in the calendar year the lifter reaches 60 years and throughout the full calendar year in which he/she reaches 69
Master 4	from 1 January in the calendar year the lifter reaches 70 years and upwards
